





Fauxchét® Twisted Infinity Cowl

Skill Level: Beginner





Finished Size: One size, Circle, 12" Width x 14" Length (laid flat) or 24" Circumference x 14" in Length.

Yarn: Yarn A, 5 oz. Worsted Weight Yarn, Green. (We chose Caron Simply Soft Yarn, Cool Green #9770, one 6 oz. skein, you'll have leftover yarn).

Yarn Tool: easyloop® fauxchét® yarn tool

Easyloop® Yarn Tool Tension: With the easyloop® yarn tool threaded with Yarn A pull needle back 1 inch and push needle into stitch 1 inch (recommended worsted weight tension) or as needed to obtain recommended gauge.

Gauge: 11 stitches and 13 rows = 4 inches.

Stitches Used: Chain Stitch; Slip Stitch; Single Fauxchét® Stitch (push tool through FRONT and BACK LOOPS of stitch). Visit www.fauxchet.com for how-to videos of the stitches used in this pattern.


Special Technique: Circular stitching in the round; Begin cowl by joining foundation chain with a slip stitch (**TWISTING** the chain **2 TIMES** before joining). Work in the round (following along with the twist in the chain as you stitch). **DO NOT ADD A TURNING STITCH** and **DO NOT TURN WORK** at the end of each row/round.

Note: For the twisted cowl the work is not turned at the end of each row/round but instead is worked in continuous rows/rounds.

Twisted Infinity Cowl

To Begin: With the easyloop® tool threaded with Yarn A (Cool Green) create a slip knot (1 inch in size) 6 inches from yarn end. Adjust so there is 1 inch between needle tip and slip knot.

Foundation Chain: Chain 60 stitches, TWIST CHAIN 2 TIMES then join chain with a SLIP STITCH. You will be working "in the round". DO NOT add turning stitch and DO NOT turn work.



Row/round 1: Slip Stitch into every stitch of foundation chain, making sure to follow the twisted chain (DON'T TRY TO STRAIGHTEN THE TWISTED CHAIN) while creating a slip stitch into every stitch of the chain. Do not turn work at end of row/round.

Rows/rounds 2-44: Single Fauxchet® into every stitch across each row/round. Do not add a turning stitch, do not turn work at the end of each row/round.

Note: The twist in the cowl occurs naturally as you stitch the rows/rounds.

Row/round 45: Slip Stitch into every stitch across row. At the end of Row 45, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch into the last stitch. Cut yarn leaving a 6 inch tail. Unthread easyloop® tool by pulling cut yarn end backward out of the tool needles. Pull yarn end to tighten the last stitch.

Finishing

Weave loose yarn ends in using the easyloop® yarn tool and the "weaving ends in" technique. ◆
