

Amazing Lace Poncho



At the end of row 73, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch into the last stitch.

FINISHED SIZE: One size $(36" \times 36")$

YARN: 12 oz. worsted weight yarn

A (black)

TOOL TENSION: With the easyloop® tool, PULL NEEDLE BACK 1 inch and PUSH NEEDLE INTO LOOP 1 inch.

GAUGE: 11 sts and 8 rows = 4 inches

STITCHES USED: SINGLE
FAUXCHÉT® (push tool through
BOTH FRONT and BACK LOOPS)
turning work at the end of each row.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES USED: SEAMING; SINGLE FAUXCHÉT® EDGING.

LACY EVENING PONCHO FRONT and BACK Pieces (Make 2)

FOUNDATION CHAIN: Using color A, chain 41 plus 1 turning stitch. Turn work.

ROW 1: With color A, slip stitch across row, making 1 turning stitch at the end of row. Turn work.

ROWS 2-72: Single fauxchét® across rows, making 1 turning stitch at the end of each row before turning work.

ROW 73: Double slip stitch loosely across row.

FINISHING

Cut yarn and weave loose ends in.

ASSEMBLY

SEAMING: Using the easyloop® tool and the SEAMING technique as shown in the instructions, with RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER sew the FRONT piece to the BACK piece following the diagram below.

EDGING AFTER SEAMING

After the FRONT and BACK pieces are joined, single fauxchét® stitch 1 row around the edges.

FINISHING

Cut yarn and weave loose ends in. <
