



baby blocks blanket

This baby blanket is a soft and cozy favorite!



Baby Blocks Blanket



FINISHED SIZE:

26" x 27"

YARN: 25 oz. bulky weight yarn
(5 oz. each of colors A-E)

A 5 oz. light blue

B 5 oz. light green

C 5 oz. light pink

D 5 oz. white

E 5 oz. purple



TOOL TENSION: With the easyloop® tool, PULL NEEDLE BACK 1 1/2 inches and PUSH NEEDLE INTO LOOP 1 1/2 inches.

GAUGE: 9 sts and 9 rows = 4 inches

STITCHES USED: **SINGLE FAUXCHÉT®** (Push tool through BOTH FRONT and BACK LOOPS) turning work at the end of each row.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES USED:


BLOCK BY BLOCK: Baby blanket is stitched one square at a time and sewn together later using the easyloop® seaming technique.

SEAMING: The squares are joined using the easyloop® tool and easy SEAMING technique.

EDGING: Once blocks are joined, 2 rows of SINGLE FAUXCHÉT® are stitched around the edges.




CHART:



Following the chart and pattern instructions, stitch individual blocks using the single fauxchét® stitch. After blocks are completed, seam the blocks together using the easyloop® SEAMING technique. To complete, stitch around the edges of the blanket using 2 rows of single fauxchét®.

BABY BLOCKS BLANKET

BLOCK A (Make 1)

MEASUREMENTS: 10" x 11"

FOUNDATION CHAIN: Using color A, chain 20 plus 1 turning stitch. Turn work.

ROW 1: With color A, slip stitch across row, making 1 turning stitch at the end of row. Turn work.

ROWS 2-18: With color A, single fauxchét® stitch across rows, making 1 turning stitch at the end of each row before turning work.

ROW 19: Slip stitch across row.

At the end of row 19, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch into the last stitch.

FINISHING: Cut yarn and weave ends in.

BLOCK B (Make 2)

MEASUREMENTS: 7" x 15"

FOUNDATION CHAIN: Using color B, chain 15 plus 1 turning stitch. Turn work.

ROW 1: With color B, slip stitch across row, making 1 turning stitch at the end of row. Turn work.

ROWS 2-28: With color B, single fauxchét® stitch across rows, making 1 turning stitch at the end of each row before turning work.

ROW 29: Slip stitch across row.

At the end of row 29, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch.

FINISHING: Cut yarn and weave ends in.

BLOCK C (Make 1)

MEASUREMENTS: 10" x 11"

FOUNDATION CHAIN: Using color C, chain 20 plus 1 turning stitch. Turn work.

ROW 1: With color C, slip stitch across row, making 1 turning stitch at the end of row. Turn work.

ROWS 2-18: With color C, single fauxchét® stitch across rows, making 1 turning stitch at the end of each row before turning work.

ROW 19: Slip stitch across row.

At the end of row 19, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch into the last stitch.

FINISHING

Cut yarn and weave loose ends in.

BLOCK D (Make 1)

MEASUREMENTS: 11" x 6"

FOUNDATION CHAIN: Using color D, chain 25 plus 1 turning stitch. Turn work.

ROW 1: With color D, slip stitch across row, making 1 turning stitch at the end of row. Turn work.

ROWS 2-12: With color D, single fauxchét® stitch across rows, making 1 turning stitch at the end of each row before turning work.

ROW 13: Slip stitch across row.

At the end of row 13, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch into the last stitch.

FINISHING: Cut yarn and weave ends in.

BLOCK E (Make 2)

MEASUREMENTS: 7" x 10"

FOUNDATION CHAIN: Using color E, chain 15 plus 1 turning stitch.
Turn work.

ROW 1: With color E, slip stitch across row, making 1 turning stitch at the end of row. Turn work.

ROWS 2-18: With color E, single fauxchét® stitch across rows, making 1 turning stitch at the end of each row before turning work.

ROW 19: Slip stitch across row.

At the end of row 19, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch into the last stitch.

FINISHING

Cut yarn and weave loose ends in.

SEAMING

Arrange the finished blocks in the order shown in the chart and with right sides of each block together, use the easyloop® SEAMING TECHNIQUE

to join the blocks into one blanket. (For the seams, use matching yarn for each block.)

EDGING D

After the blocks are completely joined into one blanket, turn blanket over to wrong side facing you.

ROW 1: Using color D, slip stitch (loosely) around the edges of the blanket (making 2 extra stitches at the corners).

ROW 2: Using color D, single fauxchét® (loosely) around the edges of the blanket (making 2 extra stitches at the corners).

ROW 3: Using color D, slip stitch (loosely) around the edges of the blanket (making 2 extra stitches at the corners).

At the end of row 3, end work by fastening off with 1 extra chain stitch.

FINISHING

Cut yarn and weave loose yarn ends in to conceal. ❖
